## What IS the Animal Emergency Management Program?

The Colorado Veterinary Medical Foundation (CVMF) has made great strides in helping our state become better prepared to deal with animal issues in disasters through the Animal Emergency Management Program (AEMP), which includes:

1. Facilitate planning for a prompt and effective response to animal emergency issues in Colorado in a manner consistent with the National Incident Management System and the Colorado Emergency Operations Plan
2. Reduce threats to the health and safety of people and animals
3. Minimize the economic impact of animal issues during emergencies
4. Maximize resources available for recovery efforts related to animals and animal agriculture

Under the overall authority of the Colorado Department of Agriculture, AEMP provides staff to lead support efforts related to companion animal and non-commercial livestock issues during disasters.



## What are our initiatives?

- Provision of training, resource development, community planning assistance, and support for local, regional, and specialized animal response team development. A core mission of the AEMP is the training and support of Community Animal Response Teams (CART).
- Coordination of the Colorado Veterinary Medical Reserve Corps (CO VMRC), a unit of the Colorado Medical Reserve Corps, which provides veterinary professionals and animal emergency responders with the training and credentialing necessary to support animal health and public health emergency response.
- Support of animal issues at the State Emergency Operations Center (SEOC) during disasters. AEMP provides staff to lead support efforts related to animal issues during disasters and to state agencies on other animal issues. AEMP also supports volunteer- and donation-management issues related to animals in disasters.
- Promotion of pet and livestock preparedness and animal industry disaster planning through each of these initiatives.
- Development of standards and best practices in animal emergency management through participation in a national alliance of similar state programs.
